Arrival and Transportation

1. Air travel

Frankfurt Airport (FRA) – The closest major airport (80 km away).

Getting to Heidelberg from the airport:

🚆 Train: Take an ICE train (~50 min, ~€25) from Frankfurt Airport to Heidelberg Hauptbahnhof (Main Station).

🚌 Shuttle Bus: Lufthansa Express Bus (~1 hour, starting at 30€). <https://www.frankfurt-airport-shuttles.de/>

🚖 Taxi/Uber: Approx. €130-150.

2. Train

Heidelberg Hauptbahnhof (Hbf) is well-connected to cities like Frankfurt, Stuttgart, and Munich.

Deutsche Bahn (DB) offers frequent ICE and regional train services.

Trams & Buses: Efficient & affordable (€2.60 per ride, day passes available).

Location "Frauenbad"

Getting to Frauenbad from Heidelberg Hauptbahnhof (Main Train Station)

🚌 Take Bus 32 or 33 from Hauptbahnhof (Süd)
Get off at Stadtbücherei (2 stops, ~5 min)

🚊 Take Tram 21, 24, or 26 from Hauptbahnhof
Get off at Seegarten (~5 min ride).

🚶 About 15 minutes on foot from the train station.

Getting Around Heidelberg from Frauenbad

To the Old Town (Altstadt):

🚌 Bus 31 or 32 to Universitätsplatz (5 min)
🚶 Or 10-12 min walk

To Heidelberg Castle:

🚊 Tram 23 to Rathaus/Bergbahn, then take the Funicular.

To Neckarwiese (Riverside Park):

🚊 Tram 5 or 23 to Brückenstraße (5 min)

Evening & Free Time Activities

After the conference, explore Heidelberg

🏰 Heidelberg Castle – Stunning ruins with panoramic views (cable car available)

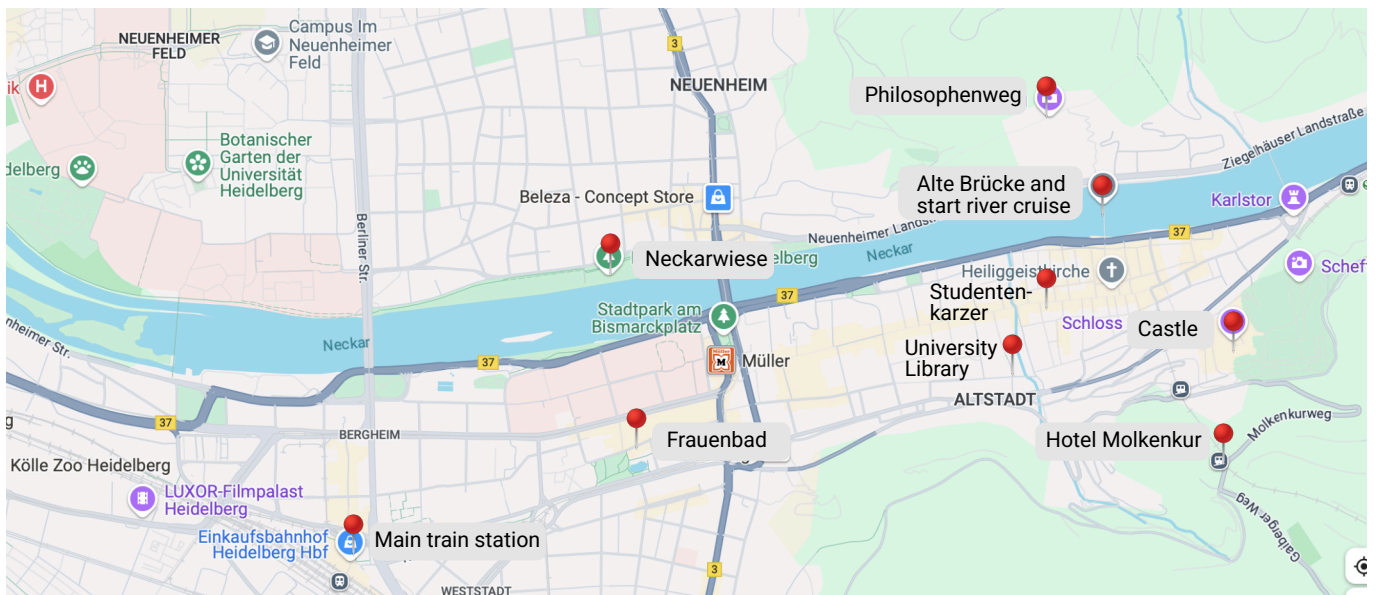
🌉 Old Bridge (Alte Brücke) – Iconic 18th-century bridge over the Neckar River

📖 Heidelberg University Library – Library of Germany's oldest university

🚤 Neckar River Cruise – Relaxing boat ride with scenic views, start at Old Bridge (Alte Brücke)

🏠 Studentenkarzer – Historic student prison and old town

🌿 Philosophenweg (Philosopher's Walk) – A scenic walking trail along the northern side of the Neckar River,

Getting to the Conference Dinner

📍 Address: Klingenteichstraße 31, 69117 Heidelberg

🏰 The dinner location sits on the hill just above the Heidelberg Castle and offers panoramic views of the city.

By public transport

1. From Frauenbad:
 - Walk to Bismarckplatz (~5 min)
 - Take Tram 23 or 5 to Rathaus/Bergbahn
 - Walk 3 min to the Kornmarkt station
 - Take the Bergbahn (funicular) to Molkenkur station
 - Short walk to the hotel (well signposted)

🚞 The Bergbahn funicular is part of Heidelberg's iconic hillside transport.

By foot

- Steep but scenic walk (~25–30 min from Old Town)
- Head toward Schloss Heidelberg and follow signs to Molkenkur
- Only recommended for those comfortable with uphill walking

By taxi

- Taxis from Bismarckplatz or Old Town take ~10–15 minutes
- Fare typically €10–15 depending on traffic
